

American History II: Literature Project



Instructions:

- You will select a book, from the provided list, which theme, plot and characters relate to the content information covered in American History II.
- You will be required to analyze your book, describe your personal reaction and reflect on your book once you have completed the reading.
- You will additionally, meet individually, with Mrs. Stewart to discuss your book.
- You will have the option of purchasing your own book or checking one out from Mrs. Stewart.
 - All books check out from Mrs. Stewart are to be turned back in, in good condition, no later than 24 March 2017.

Requirements:

- Website
 - You will be required to create your own website using weebly.com (a free website creator).
 - o Your website should be created as a **BLOG** only site.
 - o Your website address should be:
 - FirstNameLastNameWSE2017.weebly.com
 - Your website title should include:
 - Your full name
 - Boot title and author
- Journals
 - o Each new journal should be its own *new blog* post
 - o Blog post should be labeled by the journal topics (ex: Culture of the time).
 - o You will complete a total of *five* journals.
 - o *ALL* of your journals must all be completed by *Wednesday 1 March 2017*, meaning you may complete them in any order.
 - Your journals are to contain 100% analysis of the book and related topic. NO SUMMARY!
 Page numbers or chapters are strongly recommended!
 - Journals should have a minimum of 300 words and a maximum of 600 words, as well as be grammatically correct.
 - Journal Topics:
 - Culture of the Time
 - Economic Impacts
 - The Role of the Government
 - Historical changes which impact the character(s)
 - Example(s) of the American Dream
- Personal Reaction and Reflection
 - Once you have read your book and completed all five journals you will be required to reflect on the book.
 - Your personal reaction and reflection should be completed as a new blog post and should be complete as well by Wednesday 1 March 2017.
 - Your personal reaction and reflection should be a minimum of 500 words and a maximum of 700 words, as well as be grammatically correct.

Grading:

- You will receive a **QUIZ** grade for the following aspects of this project:
 - o Creating your website and meeting all website requirements
 - Each analysis journal of your book
 - Your personal reaction and reflection blog
- Once the project is complete all grades will be averaged together for a **PROJECT** grade.
